Bring DL, License plate number, make and model of car. Priority for parking passes will be given to Seniors and Juniors. If you senior or junior student is licensed and plans to drive during the school year YOU MUST purchase at the beginning of the school year to take advantage of this policy!! Effective November 1, 2017, if passes are still available, sales will be open to licensed Sophomores.

(#601) ASB Sticker: \$30 for year \$ _____
ASB designation on Student Body card: allowing students to attend all home and athletic & other school Activities during the year for a reduced rate. **REQUIRED for ALL sports and club participation**

(#411) Concert Band (excludes Marching Band): \$45 \$ _____

(#419) Choir: Concert and Varsity Choir \$20 \$ _____

Families qualifying for Free and Reduced Meals have access to additional services and scholarships. These include:

- **Sprint 1million Project:** 4J will provide free smartphones or other wireless devices and high-speed internet connectivity to eligible High school students
- **Driver’s Training Scholarship**
- **Reduction in athletic fees**
- **Aid for college bound students** – see your counselor
- **Bus Passes:** If your high school student is on the Free /Reduced Meal Program, they may be eligible for a free monthly bus pass.

For a student to receive a free monthly bus pass they must:

1. Provide documentation of qualification for Free and Reduced Lunch Program
2. Live more than 1.5 miles from school- this is the address of record, if two households.
3. Do not reside on a 4J school bus route
