

2019-20 Back to School Registration & Enrollment

Enrollment:

New students should try to complete enrollment for 2019-20 *before* Registration Day on August 27th. Sheldon's Registrar is available for enrollment during Summer office hours, and regular office hours resume on August 14th, 8:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m (Monday – Friday). New enrollments will be accepted on Registration Day, but we encourage you to enroll ahead of time to help your Registration Day run smoothly.

You will also need your state-issued photo ID, two proofs of address, immunization record, and previous high school transcript (if you have one). Refer to the enrollment forms for a list of acceptable ID and proof of address.

Registration:

All students are expected to attend registration. Students will receive Student Profiles (for updating contact information), class schedules, pay fees, turn in forms, take school photos and get ID cards.

Registration times are organized by grade:

Freshmen 8:30 am to 10:30 am

Sophomores: 10:30 am to 12:00 pm

Closed – lunch 12:00 pm to 12:45 pm

Seniors: 12:45 pm to 2:15 pm

Juniors: 2:15 pm to 3:45 pm

Payment in the form of cash, check or charge should also accompany your completed checklist. Fees may be paid in advance by either going online and using [SchoolPay.com](#) or through the Finance Office PRIOR to Registration.

Athletic fees will not be accepted at Registration. Athletic fees should be paid directly to the Finance Office before the first contest date which begins the week of August 26th.

PSAT testing: Testing Day is October 16, 2019. Unlike last year, we anticipate juniors will not be charged for the PSAT. However, juniors will need to register through their Naviance account in order to take the exam. Watch for more communication in August.

Parking:

All motor vehicles parked on the Sheldon campus must display a current Sheldon parking permit. The requirement for the permit includes a completed parking contract and a \$50 permit fee. The parking policy is outlined in our current Sheldon HS 2019-20 Parking Policy [Parking Policy/Policy Permit Parking](#). Due to parking space limitations, privileges are available to senior and junior students *only*. Once passes are sold-out, no additional passes will be made available, regardless of your grade. Please be aware that

students violating the parking contract and/or regulations may be ticketed, and/or may have parking privileges revoked at any time.
