

DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP

During distance learning, most student-student and teacher-student interaction will take place online. Just as we care for one another in person, it is important that we take good care of our digital community, treating others with dignity, respect, and kindness. These are expectations we maintain when meeting in a “brick and mortar” environment as well.

The following are guidelines to keep our interactions healthy and appropriate:

- **Zoom Meetings and other video platforms used for school**
 - During large Zoom meetings or other chat platforms, students should mute themselves to allow for clear communication.
 - Use the chat to ask any questions. Teachers may open up opportunities to share in an unmuted forum. Follow teacher direction.
 - Do not record (audio or video) another student or teacher on Zoom or other video platforms
 - Remember, you are on video, so any actions, gestures, behaviors inappropriate in a school setting would be considered inappropriate in a virtual setting.
- **Chats / Emails / video platforms / Google docs / or any school-used platform, etc**
 - Conversation should be related to school-related topics.
 - Use school appropriate language
 - Be kind to one another. Speak respectfully about others in our learning community.

Consequences will vary depending on the seriousness of the situation, and may include disciplinary action such as parent contact, detention, suspension, expulsion, and or referring to police when appropriate.
