CREDIT RECOVERY COURSES

Online credit recovery is available for students in grades 10–12 (Fall, 2020) to recover credit for math, science, social studies, and language arts courses previously taken and not passed. Credit recovery courses will be taken through the Fuel Ed online platform, and most will be supported remotely by 4J teachers. All courses will be graded Pass/Not Pass.

Registered students will begin July 20 and complete courses by August 21, 2020. Students will be required to complete bi-weekly check-ins with their teacher and must be making progress toward course completion.
