Naviance passwords can be reset by your counselor.

Naviance has a variety of tools to help you with your post high school planning. You can find personal assessments to help you narrow down which careers would best match your personality and strengths. These can be found under “**Self-Discovery**”. You can also search different career paths, occupations, the degrees/certifications they require, and the average salary made. This can be found under “**Careers**” and “**Explore Clusters & Pathways**”.
