- All students complete a research project in their junior & senior years in their subject area.
- 37 concentrations (majors)
 - 31 Bachelors of Art
 - 6 Bachelors of Science & Engineering
- 95% of students live on campus all 4 years
 - Guaranteed housing available for all students for all 4 years
 - 6 residential colleges
 - Each have their own colors & theme
- Social, athletics, and academic clubs available
- Recommend getting involved with a club in your subject area because professors often mentor the clubs
 - This is a good way to build a network for post-graduation
- Financial Aid Availability:
 - Available to all including undocumented & international students
 - 100% need base, no athletic or merit scholarships
 - 83% of students graduate debt free
 - Grants not loans
- Admission:
 - Holistic approach- they look beyond academics, how will you fit on campus & contribute to the Princeton community? Want students who will take advantage of Princeton's resources. Will you make a good roommate?
- Applying:
 - Common App
 - Princeton Supplement: Questions from Princeton
 - Graded written papers from your high school courses
 - Transcript
 - School Report
 - School Counselor Letter
 - Two teacher recommendations
 - SAT or ACT scores (not required this year)
 - TOEFL, IELTS, PTE (if not a native English speaker or without 3 years of high school in English)
- Deadlines:
 - Early Action:
 - Application & Princeton Supplement Due: November 1
 - Financial Aid: November 9
 - Notified About Acceptance: Mid December

- Candidate Reply: May
- Regular Decision:
 - Application & Princeton Supplement Due: January 1
 - Financial Aid Due: February 1
 - Notified About Acceptance: April
