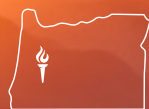

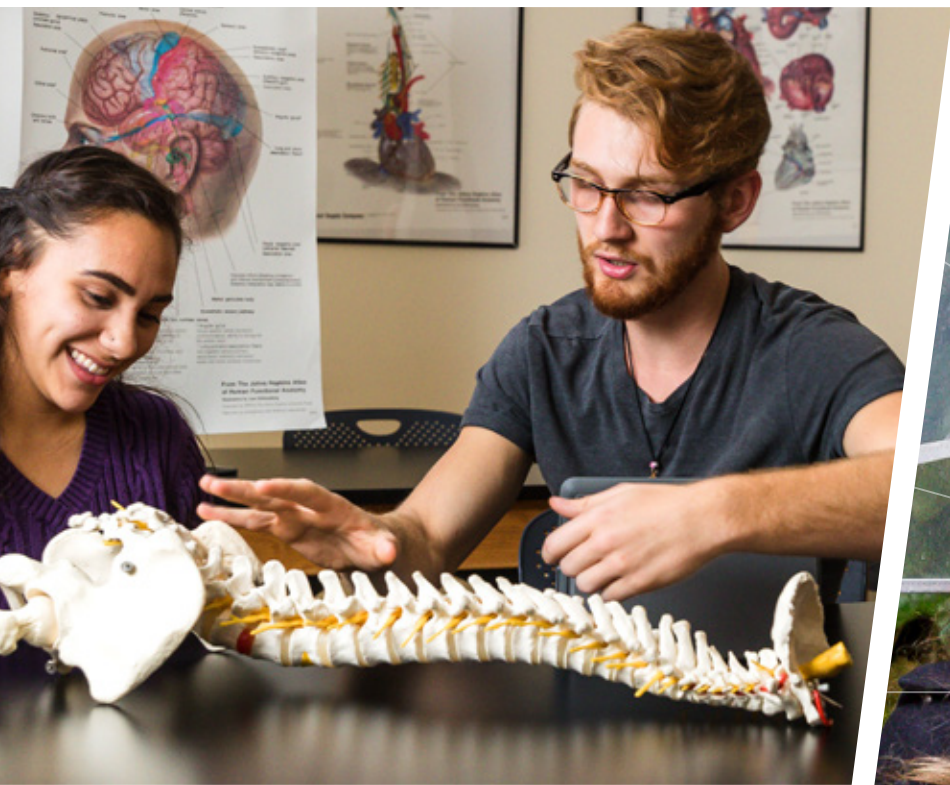

THE RESIDENTIAL EXPERIENCE

Students who are married, over the age of 21, or living with their parents are exempt from on-campus residency.

CHAPEL

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

Bushnell University students, faculty and staff work with numerous service organizations such as Special Olympics, St. Vincent DePaul, Eugene Mission and Hosea Youth Ministry. Faith will be strengthened through programs like Night of Prayer, The Touch Project, Embrace the City Day and Spiritual Formation Week, as well as mission trips to destinations that in the past have included San Francisco, Seattle, Nicaragua, Cambodia, Africa, Puerto Rico and Mexico.
