FAFSA/ORSAA Completion Night

**Seniors, have you completed for FAFSA?
Was it accepted?**

Join us on June 6 in the Sheldon Library! Starting promptly at 6 pm counselors & the Career Center will be available to help you complete and submit your FAFSA/ORSAA! Computers will be available! This will be our final FAFSA Completion Night.

To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®), you will need:

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically.

If you are a [dependent student](#), then you will also need most of the above information for your parent(s).
